WHEREAS, The Webster Parish Police Jury Declaration filed with the *Clerk of Court*, document file # 610201 that was issued on 10/16/2024, declared an emergency condition *due to the lack of rainfall and extreme heat conditions that created dangerous fire conditions for the parish.*

WHEREAS, The Webster Parish Fire Chiefs Association agrees, that *there is no longer a threat of dangerous fire conditions for the Parish*; and requested the Burn Ban in effect for Webster Parish be lifted.


WHEREAS, When the President of the Webster Parish Police Jury determines that the threat of danger has been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist, the state of emergency may be terminated by executive order or proclamation;

WHEREAS, there is no longer a need to continue certain specific emergency orders;

THEREFORE, *I, Jim Bonsall, President of the Webster Parish Police Jury, by authority vested in me by the Parish Charter and the Louisiana Disaster Act, do hereby proclaim;*

The STATE of EMERGENCY document file # 610201 that was issued on 10/16/2024 *no longer exists within Webster Parish effective immediately.*
