NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come The Cullen Board of Alderman, through the Town of Cullen, Louisiana, Terry Hoof in his official capacity as Mayor for the Town of Cullen, Yolanda Castleman in her official capacity as Alderman for the Town of Cullen, Barbara Green in her official capacity as Alderman for the Town of Cullen, Denise Epps Hoof in her official capacity as Alderman for the Town of Cullen, Floydean White in her official capacity as Alderman for the Town of Cullen, and Bianchi Veal, in her official capacity as Alderman for the Town of Cullen (collectively, "Town of Cullen" or "Defendants"), who file this *Contested Motion to Continue Trial and Incorporated Memorandum in Support* (the "Motion") and respectfully requests a continuance of the trial in this matter currently set for August 5, 2026, for the reasons that follow:

On April 7, 2025, Fannie Rankin ("Chief Rankin") filed a *Petition for Declaratory Judgment, Temporary Restraining Orders, Preliminary and Permanent Injunction and Damages* in this matter.

After a pre-trial conference on April 7, 2026, this Court reset the Bench Trial in this matter and entered an order on May 29, 2026, setting the trial for August 5, 2026.
